What is the Life Cycle Survey?

The survey gathers life cycle inventory data of wood products manufactured in the U.S. to generate Life Cycle Assessment (LCA) studies that form the basis of Environmental Product Declarations (EPD).



How is the LCA produced?

The survey collects various types of data from mills related to production, energy use and waste. Examples of the types of data collected include:
